What kind of data do we process and which sources do we use?

What purpose do we process your data for?

The Email address will be used for providing you the interim results as well as the final results. The areas of expertise will be aggregated to determine and overall respondent profile.

Will the data be transmitted to third parties?

Your personal data will only be processed by employees of Bauhaus Luftfahrt e.V. who are involved in the survey and will not be passed on to third parties.

Will the AI agents used in the survey process any personal data?

No. The AI agents we create do not ingest or process any personal data.

Legal basis

Participation in this research study is entirely voluntary.

Bauhaus Luftfahrt processes the personal data in accordance with the requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the German Federal Data Protection Regulation (BDSG).

Storage and deletion of data

We only store your personal data as long as it is necessary to achieve the purposes stated here. Therefore your email address will be deleted after the final result has been sent.

Your rights of data subjects

You can exercise the following rights at any time using the contact details provided by our Data Protection Officer:

- Information about your data stored with us and their processing
- Correction of incorrect personal data
- Deletion of your data stored with us
- Restriction of data processing if we are not yet allowed to delete your data due to legal obligations
- Objection against the processing of your data by us
- Data transferability if you have consented to data processing or have concluded a contract with us

If you have given us your consent, you can revoke it at any time with effect for the future.

You may at any time lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority responsible for you. Your competent supervisory authority depends on the federal state of your residence, your work or the alleged violation.
