Which sources do we use and for what purpose do we process your data?

Bauhaus Luftfahrt processes the personal data in accordance with the requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the German Federal Data Protection Regulation (BDSG). We process the personal data that you have provided to us in the registration form to participate at the Bauhaus Luftfahrt Symposium.

This data will be used for:

- the registration of the Bauhaus Luftfahrt Symposium

If you have given us your consent, we also use the data for:

- the dispatch of yearbooks and other printed products (flyers etc.) by post
- the dispatch of information and invitations to Bauhaus Luftfahrt events by e-mail and by post
- business purposes

Will the data be transmitted to third parties?

- Your personal data will only be processed by employees of Bauhaus Luftfahrt and will not be passed on to third parties

You can object to the processing of your personal data by Bauhaus Luftfahrt at any time by sending an e-mail to the following address:

Storage, deletion or blocking of data

We adhere to the principles of data avoidance and data economy. We therefore only store your personal data as long as it is necessary to achieve the purposes stated here or as long as we are obliged by the legal regulations. Your data will be routinely blocked or deleted in accordance with the statutory regulations as soon as the respective purpose has ceased or after expiration of the legal storage period.

Your rights of data subjects

You can exercise the following rights at any time using the contact details provided by our Data Protection Officer:

- Information about your data stored with us and their processing
- Correction of incorrect personal data
- Deletion of your data stored with us
- Restriction of data processing if we are not yet allowed to delete your data due to legal obligations
- Objection against the processing of your data by us
- Data transferability if you have consented to data processing or have concluded a contract with us

If you have given us your consent, you can revoke it at any time with effect for the future.

You may at any time lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority responsible for you. Your competent supervisory authority depends on the federal state of your residence, your work or the alleged violation.
